- 2. Search for systematic reviews at PubMed.
- 3. Search for meta-analyses at PubMed.
- 4. Search for randomized control trials at PubMed.

Analyzing Evidence-Based Research

- 1. Skim the abstract for main concepts.
- 2. Review any unfamiliar terms.
- 3. Critique each step of the research process.
- 4. Explain the study in your own words.

Acting on Evidence-Based Research

- 1. Explore intervention options.
- 2. Understand the benefits, risks, and alternatives.
- 3. Make an informed decision.
- 4. Evaluate the outcome of the decision.
